Step 1: Commit to Compete

Set Clear Goals

Do you want to place, gain experience, or build your studio's reputation?

Take Action Now

Register your intent with the UK Hip-Hop Dance Championship and lock in your mindset.

Step 2: Choose Your Crew Structure

Identify Your Talent

Assess your dancers—who is competition-ready? Who has potential?

Strategic Mix

Use a mix of big groups for impact and small teams for precision.



Step 3: Know the Rules

1 Read the Rulebook


Read the Championship <u>rulebook</u> carefully to maximise your score and prevent disqualifications.

2 Meet Requirements

Ensure all dancers meet age and crew size requirements.

Set Reminders

Set calendar reminders for each deadline—avoid last-minute panic.



Step 4: Lock in Your Routine



Dynamic Music

Start with Music that inspires you and showcases your crew's best abilities.



Signature Moves

Incorporate your signature move and put your unique style on the plate! Don't imitate, innovate!!



Versatility

Use three street dance styles to showcase versatility and maximise your score.

Step 5: Train Like Champions

1 Champions Don't Think About Winning

Champions think about the next step.

Master Skills

Practice drills for precision, synchronicity, and speed.

Radiate Confidence

Believe in your abilities and let that shine through. Every movement and gesture should exude self-assurance.

Clean, Clean, Clean!

It's the little things done well that blow the judges away.
Establish a habit of Flawless execution by cleaning, cleaning and cleaning.



Step 6: Stand Out

Powerful Music

Again, choose a powerful, music that inspires you.

Street Dress

Wear bold, comfortable clothes that allow movement - But keep it *real*. See rules for guidelines.

Unique Identity

Establish your crew's identity—a unique name, theme, or color scheme.

Use the entire stage

To maximize your score while working the formations.

Incorporate different levels


To make the performance more dynamic and increase your overall score ensure smooth transitions from the floor to the air.

Expand Your Digital Presence

Build Competitor Connections

Network with other competing crews to learn from their experiences and find inspiration for your own journey.

Review judge feedback and performance footage to identify strengths and areas for improvement.


